It is surrounded by beautiful villas, resort villages, mountains and hills with hiking paths and it's popular for boat trips and water activities. Lake Como lies on the Milan to Switzerland train line. Lake Como, Italy weather is famed for its mild temperatures and balmy, Mediterranean sunshine.
