Itinerary:

Day 1: Upon arrival at Columbus Airport you will be met by your World of Travel tour director who assists with check in as you board the flight to Las Vegas. Once in Vegas, you board the deluxe motorcoach for Utah the first exiting point of interest, Zion National Park. Zion covers some 150,000 acres of wild canyon country east of St. George, Utah and is located at the junction of the Colorado Plateau, Great Basin and Mojave Desert provinces. Following the tour, you settle into the Majestic View Lodge located on the edge of Zion National Park. Dinner is served at the lodge restaurant.

Day 2: Following breakfast at the hotel, the morning's drive allows an opportunity to enjoy Zion National Park's beauty as you travel to Bryce Canyon National Park. At Bryce, erosion has shaped thousands colorful into of spires, pinnacles and mazes called "hoodoos." These colorful and whimsical formations stand in horseshoe-shaped amphitheaters along the Paunsaugunt Plateau in Southern Utah. After your tour of Bryce Canyon, overnight at Ruby Inn and enjoy dinner at your hotel.

Day 3: Enjoy a beautiful scenic drive through the Escalante and Vermillion wilderness to our home for the evening in Page, AZ, home to Lake Powell. In 1869 thirty five year old Major John Wesley Powell led ten men in four boats on a journey that would cover almost 1,000 miles through uncharted canyons and change the west forever. Check in to Wahweep Lodge for the night at one of Lake Powell's popular resorts. Enjoy a dinner cruise on the crystal clear water of Lake Powell, cruising along the winding canyons and sheer cliff walls this evening.

Day 4: After breakfast journey through the Old West to one of the worlds 7 Natural Wonders, the spectacular Grand Canyon. Don't forget your binoculars and camera! Located entirely in northern Arizona, the park encompasses 277 miles of the Colorado River and adjacent upland and offers some of the most spectacular scenery anywhere in the world. Tonight your accommodations the next two evenings will be the Maswik Lodge located near the Southern Rim of the Grand Canyon. Enjoy dinner this evening overlooking the Grand Canyon.

Day 5: After breakfast at the hotel, you will have a leisurely morning to explore the Grand Canyon. Picturesque paths and cement walkways will direct you to the rim of the canyon where souvenir shops and observation areas are plentiful. Watch the condors soar overhead – don't forget your binoculars and camera! Your Tour Director will provide detailed directions, commentary and transportation along the rim today. This evening enjoy dinner together as you share thoughts of today's magnificent tour of the Grand Canyon.

Day 6: Following breakfast at the hotel, it's on the road again as you make your way to Las Vegas, NV. When you're not winning in the casino, lounging by the pool or savoring delicious cuisine, you'll find that Las Vegas has a variety of must-see attractions and entertainment that appeal to people of all ages. Enjoy the day on your own to find what Las Vegas has to offer. Your hotel this evening is located along the famous Las Vegas "strip."

Day 7: Enjoy the buffet breakfast at your leisure then relax and enjoy a leisurely morning in Vegas prior to the transfer to the airport and your return flight to Columbus.
