## SAMPLE OPTIONAL DAY TOURS:

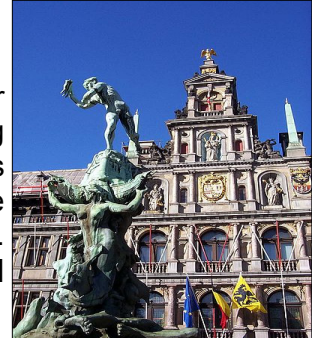
**Amsterdam, Holland** is an eclectic mix of old and new, historical charm and cosmopolitan flair. It's a blend of cultures, but still quintessentially Dutch and is the charming capital of the Netherlands. It is renowned for its colorful gardens, magnificent museums, endless latticework of canals, and abundance of bicycles. History and culture are evident in the 800-year-old city where you can explore the Rijks Museum, with works of Rembrandt and other Dutch masters.



\* One day to Amsterdam via rail with guided tour of Amsterdam, entrance to the Van Gogh Museum and a canal ride through the city- (Flower visits if in spring) - \$299.00 per person

**Antwerp, Belgium,** The diamond capitol of Europe - One of the world's major seaports, Antwerp is filled with narrow, winding streets and classic buildings, including the Cathedral of Notre Dame, Belgium's finest and largest Gothic church. Antwerp is home to 17th century painter Peter Paul Rubens, whose works are displayed in the Royal Museum of Fine Arts and Church of St. James, the painter's burial site.
